The Attorney General is reviewing the proposed affiliation and change of control and governance of East Bay Integrated Care, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, and Chapters Health System, Inc. a Florida not-for-profit corporation. East Bay Integrated Care, Inc. operates a hospice agency and a 6-bed inpatient hospice facility, Bruns House, located at 2849 Miranda Avenue, in Alamo, California. The proposed transaction is being reviewed by the Attorney General as required by Corporations Code sections 5920 *et seq*. The terms of the proposed affiliation are set forth in the written notice to the Attorney General. Under the affiliation agreement dated October 2, 2024, Chapters Health System, Inc. will become the sole corporate member of East Bay Integrated Care, Inc. According to the parties, the proposed affiliation will be one of four initial affiliations with hospice organizations that comprise a new division of Chapters Health, "Chapters West Region," for the provision of hospice services in California, Oregon, and Nevada. The stated purpose of the affiliation is to preserve existing hospice and palliative care services for the communities served by East Bay Integrated Care, Inc., to address rising competition from for-profit hospice organizations and staffing shortages, and to enhance existing services.

The California Attorney General will conduct a public meeting on June 24, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the administrative offices of East Bay Integrated Care, Inc. located at 3470 Buskirk Ave, Pleasant Hill, CA 94523. The purpose of the public meeting is to receive public comments on the proposed transaction.
